DOL is reaching out to WCOE and small business owners across America on a fact-finding mission to learn how they can do a better job setting prevailing wage and benefit rates.

A perfect storm has been created by the intersection of President Obama's Executive Order virtually mandating all projects using Federal dollars be subject to Project Labor Agreements; the Government Accountability Office reporting that the DOL is using inadequate statistical information to determine prevailing wages; and the SBA determining in its WOSB (8m) Program research that the construction industry is woefully underrepresented in the federal governing contracting arena.
